ITEMS ACCEPTED AT DUMPSTER DAY:

- Old furniture, desks, drawers, mattresses, box springs
- Counter tops, hardware, toilets, glass, carpet and padding
- Lumber, fencing, wood, logs
- Lawn mowers (**fluids drained**), tires
- Plastic toys, small plastic appliances
- **Clean** concrete, brick, cinder blocks, rock
- Packing Styrofoam: **MUST** be placed in a clear plastic bags and tied

DO:

- Please remain in your car unless you are unloading items
- When unloading items, please unload towards the back of the bin to maximize space
- Bring people to help unload items, as it is self service

ITEMS NOT ACCEPTED AT DUMPSTER DAY [DO NOT BRING]:

- **Commercial waste, Household Garbage**, Food waste, Recyclables, Cardboard or Yard Waste. Trailers over 4x8 will be turned away.
- **Electronic Waste** (no computers, TV's, etc.)
- **Liquids**, Paint, Oil, Solvents, Gel, Pastes, Inhalants, Needles
- **Tires**
- **Refrigerators**
- Automotive and Cleaning Products
- Fertilizers, Pesticides
- Fluorescent Light Bulbs
- Gas cylinders and Tanks
- "Peanut" packaging pellets- put these in bags, tie, and place in a garbage container
- **Pharmaceuticals**- Dispose of unwanted/expired pharmaceuticals: www.sjenvironment.org/preventing-water-pollution

DON'T:

- Don't bring more people than needed to unload items
- Don't bring in donations, as they will not be accepted
